Becoming a Library Volunteer

Volunteer opportunities vary at each location. Please speak with the volunteer coordinator to discuss your interest.

Sometimes, notices announcing opportunities to volunteer at the library are posted in each library branch. The notice gives information about the specific task for which a volunteer is needed, and lists any special requirement or skill needed. Volunteer opportunities may be long-term or short-term.

A volunteer application is on the reverse side. The application must be filled out completely. Because opportunities to volunteer at the library are limited, and we do our best to match a volunteer's interest and skills with the volunteer opportunity, an interview is required. Students interested in volunteering to fulfill the Student Service Graduation Requirement, like other volunteers, must complete an application and have an interview. Student volunteers must have their parents sign the application.
